CBAG Objectives



- Gain a better understanding into the mechanics of both coastal erosion & land slippage
- Explore mitigation measures to prevent or minimise the effects of both coastal erosion & land slippage:
 - Improved drainage
 - Stabilisation planting programme
 - Physical reinforcement/stabilisation
- Explore joint community project involvement with educational or industry expert resources
- Information & resource sharing with other local communities experiencing similar challenges
- Evaluate cost and/or local labour requirements to support work requirements
- Explore potential funding sources for community based environmental work
- Carry out & complete remedial community work
- Monitor future movement



Work Caried Out Over The Last 12 Months





General maintenance

- Checked/cleared existing drainage ditches (spring 2017); most found flowing well, minor corrective work, flexible pipe has significantly reduced required maintenance
- Many of the saplings not looking too good however...

North End Platipus Installation

- Completed scoping exercise
- Funding for consumables applied for and awarded (with thanks to the Hillhead of Auguhirie Wind Farm Community Fund)
- Funding application for installation of anchors being prepared (St. John's Hill Wind Farm Community Fund)

Sea defences

- Engagement with Aberdeenshire Council
- Scope of Work for feasibility study being prepared by CBAG
- Indications are that feasibility study could be (part-)funded by Aberdeenshire Council

Work Planned For The Next 12 Months





- General maintenance (spring and autumn 2018)
 - Check/clear existing drainage ditches
 - General inspection of the braes
- Sea defences
 - Complete feasibility study Scope of Work document and submit to Aberdeenshire Council with request to award the study to one of their preferred engineering houses
 - It should provide an indication of potential feasible options, taking into account the physical access and funding constraints

North End Platipus Installation (May/June)





Platipus trial, but without requirement for Plati-Drains and re-profiling with additional top soil / sand bags

 However, it is still a tough piece of work, requiring strong and able individuals...

We are therefore pursuing an option to outsource the installation of the anchors by a qualified contractor, subject to pricing and availability of funding from St John's Hill Wind Farm Community Fund

Path Maintenance (April/May)






- Existing posts and panels corroded, causing path to become unstable
- We have new scaffolding poles (kindly donated by Westgrove Construction)
- Suitable panels to be sourced
- Should be a relatively quick repair, but needs to be completed before rose hip bushes start growing


